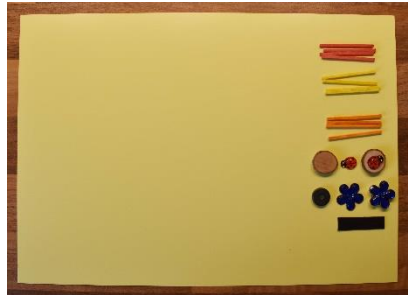




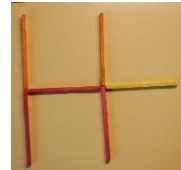
## Noughts and Crosses

During the Covid-19 when we all had to maintain social distance, I tried to regularly send my grandkids some little – unusual - homemade presents to brighten up their time at home. I designed these magnetic A5 cards using various embellishments I already had.



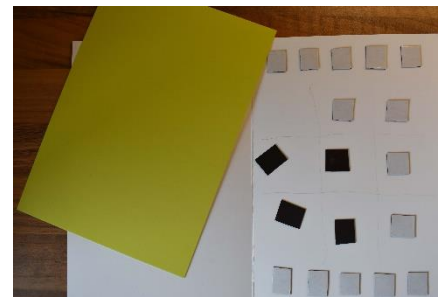
### Step 1:

You will need an A4 piece of card in a colour of your choice. I have used 12 matchsticks in a mixture of colours to add some extra vibrance to the grid and super glued them to the card. The five pieces for each player are made from a combination of magnets and shapes appropriate to the child.



### Step 2:

Using a flat, magnetic strip, cut a sufficient size to hold the player's piece and stick these in the appropriate places on the inside of the card. Make sure to check they are stuck on correctly so that the round magnets will be held. Cut a piece of card to fit the inside of the card and glue in place to cover the magnetic squares.



### Step 3:

Prepare the players' pieces using strong magnets and superglue. Make 5 pieces for each player.
